Our pedagogical assistance

Intercultural exchange is not a matter of age or previous knowledge, it is more a question of individual consultation and professional assistance to find the program that fits to each volunteer. We offer program- and country specific trainings and everyday mentoring by our staff in charge, local coordinators, and partner organizations. With us it is possible to find the right match for each individual volunteer.

Our roots

The VIA story began in 1992 in Lüneburg: VIA e.V. - the nonprofit organization for international and intercultural exchange was founded by people with idealism, curiosity and who enjoy international contact. The organization is non-partisan and non-religious.



VIA - locations and team

At our locations in Lüneburg, Berlin, and Leipzig we have approximately 20 employees, who have long-term experience in intercultural and educational work. They supervise and support our volunteers.

About 30 trainers offer a thorough and intensive pedagogical preparation in diversified preparatory- and follow up seminars.

Former volunteers enrich our work by giving helpful feedback and sharing their experiences. Some of them work for us either in student jobs, as seminar assistants, or support us as volunteers.

Many of them keep in touch with their former projects on a long-term basis and continue to actively support them even after their return to Germany. Our volunteers spread informations by giving presentations and writing blogs. Some set up their own nonprofit organizations, collect donations, or actively become a part of other NGOs that work toward common global goals.

Long-term volunteer service

is our main focus.

With the funding programs "weltwärts", "IJFD", and "EFD" we send volunteers over 18 years old to work in many different social services. For example, work with disabled people, or in schools or in children's homes.

This volunteer service is usually for one year.

Long-term volunteer service is co-financed by the German Federal Ministry for Family, Senior Citizens, Women, and Youth (BMFSFJ), the German Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) as well as the European Commission (EC).

Host family stays and internships

Host family stays and internships have been a part of our program since the very beginning. Interested people of all ages can use this opportunity to immerse themselves in another world, through different internship possibilities (for example, teaching, researching, taking care of children) or through spending time in host families where they get a chance to learn about other countries, and engage in an intercultural exchange with its people. Language courses, social activities and return visits complete our portfolio. Host family stays and internships are available in various countries in Eastern Europe, Latin America. Africa and Asia.

Coming to Germany: "Incoming"

It has been part of our exchange philosophy right from the beginning of our organization to receive young people from foreign countries to volunteer in Germany.



Currently about 80 international volunteers from all over the world are working in facilities for disabled people, senior citizens, children and youth in Germany.

The incoming programs are called "European Voluntary Service" (EFD), "Federal Voluntary Service" (BFD), "Voluntary Social Year" (FSJ) and "Weltwärts South-North". They are funded by the German Federal Ministry for Family, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth (BMFSFI) as well as German Federal Ministry of Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and the European Commission. The programs are usually planned for a one-year period.
